## Y O U T H & S C H O O L S O U T R E A C H

### Extraordinary

In today's society, young people are given a small window through which they can only view carefully selected parts of other people's lives. As a result, social media has caused many people to feel like their lives are less than extraordinary.

In this RE lesson, we study the lives of two of the Bible's most notable personalities, Abraham and Ruth, and see that life can be extraordinary for all of us if we put God first.

### Persecution

Examining the issues of Christian persecution, this interactive programme challenges young people to consider the reality of Christians who suffer for their faith around the world.

### Empty

The resurrection of Jesus has been described as, *“the pivot upon which all of Christianity turns.”* In 'Empty,' we explore this key historic event, discuss why an empty tomb is central to the Christian faith, and consider the serious consequences if the resurrection of Jesus is a lie.

### Kingdom Stories —

*The Prodigal Son/ The Good Samaritan/ The Wheat & The Weeds/ The Sower and Seed*

Jesus used stories to teach people about the Kingdom of God. In this programme, we examine how these stories can help us understand more about God and about ourselves, with a focus on the choice of the parable of The Prodigal Son, The Good Samaritan, The Wheat and The Weeds and The Sower and Seed.

### Temptation

In this programme we explore the question, *“what does it mean to be tempted?”* We look at how Jesus was tempted by the devil in the wilderness. We discuss how Jesus can be an example for Christians, and how we can apply this to our own lives when we face temptation.

### Living Letters

Where did the Bible come from, why is it so important and how can we read it effectively? This programme examines the origin of the Bible, its content, and teaches young people how to read it for themselves.

### It's A Miracle

Jesus performed many miracles during his ministry on earth. What do they tell us about him and what can we learn from them?
